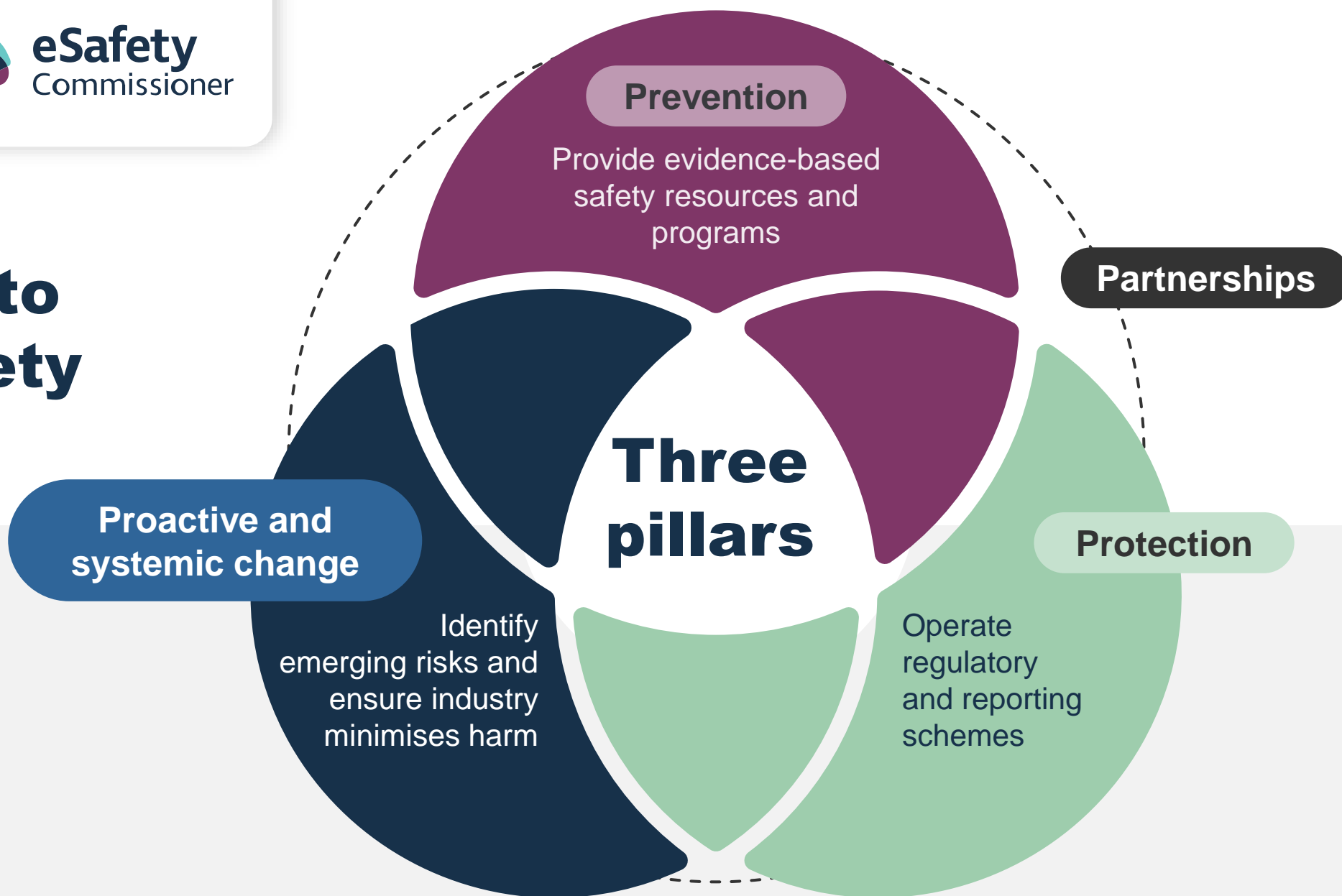

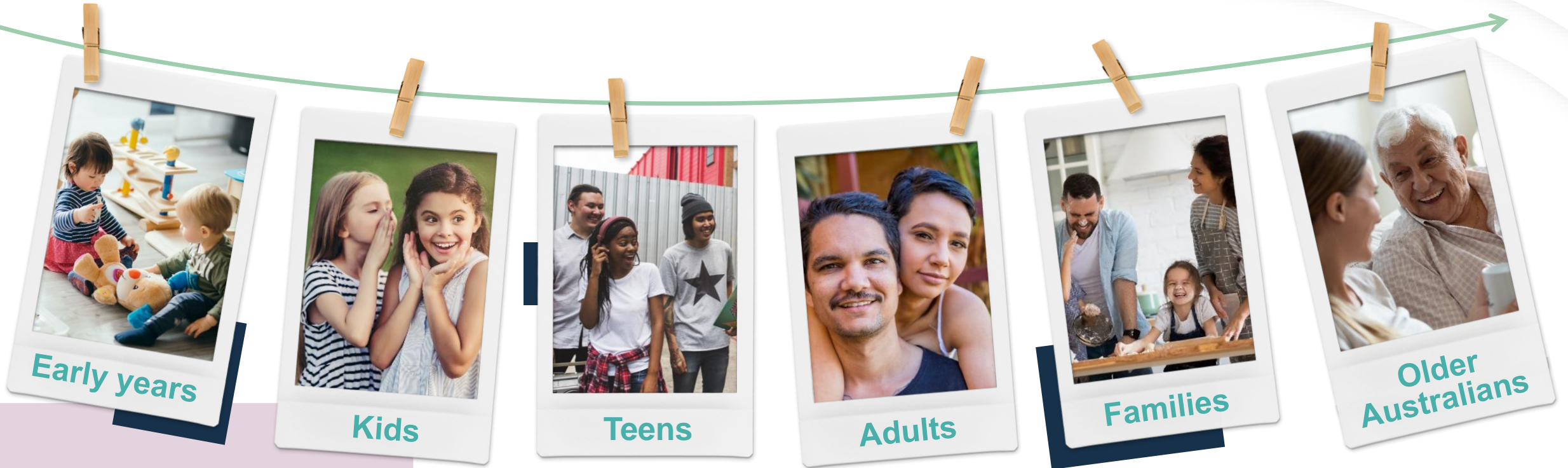

Be Connected is an Australian Government initiative developed to increase the **confidence, skills** and **online safety** of older Australians.



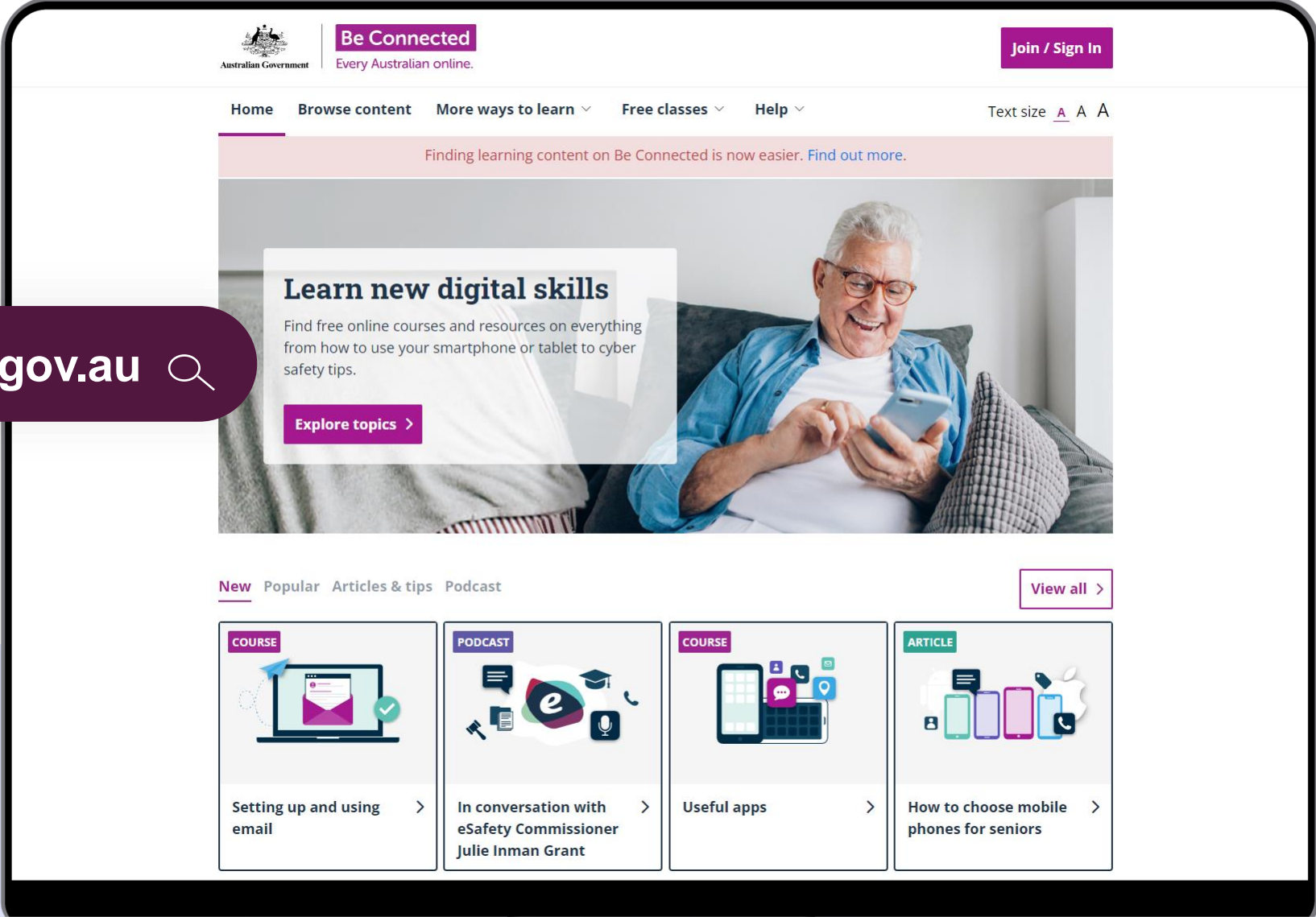

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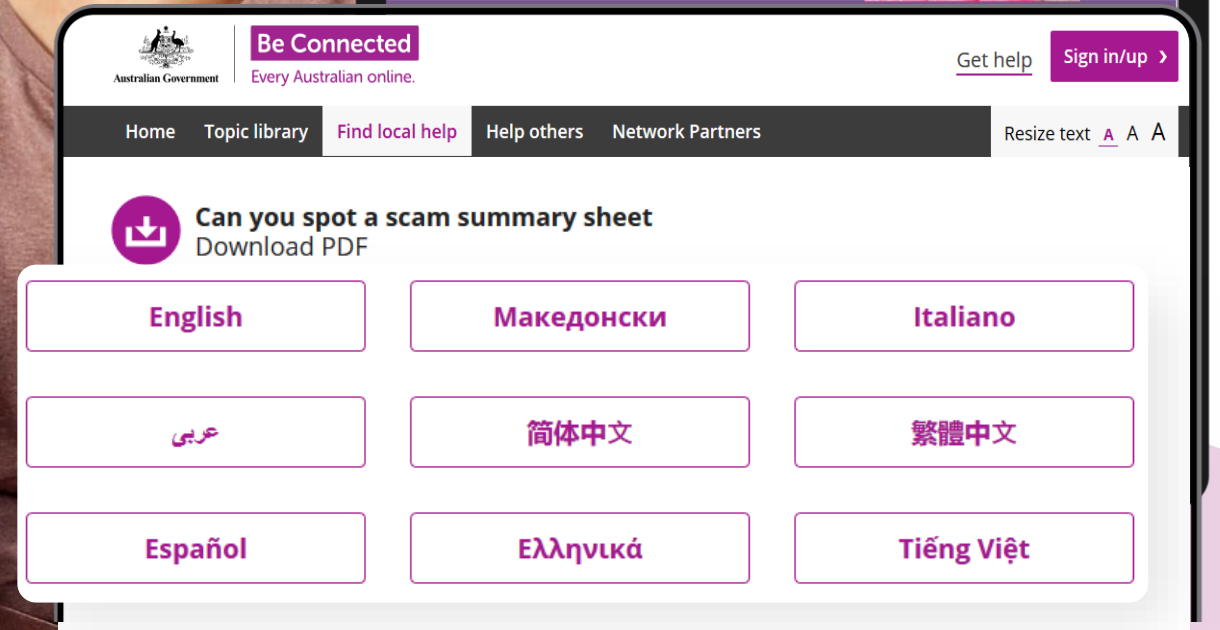
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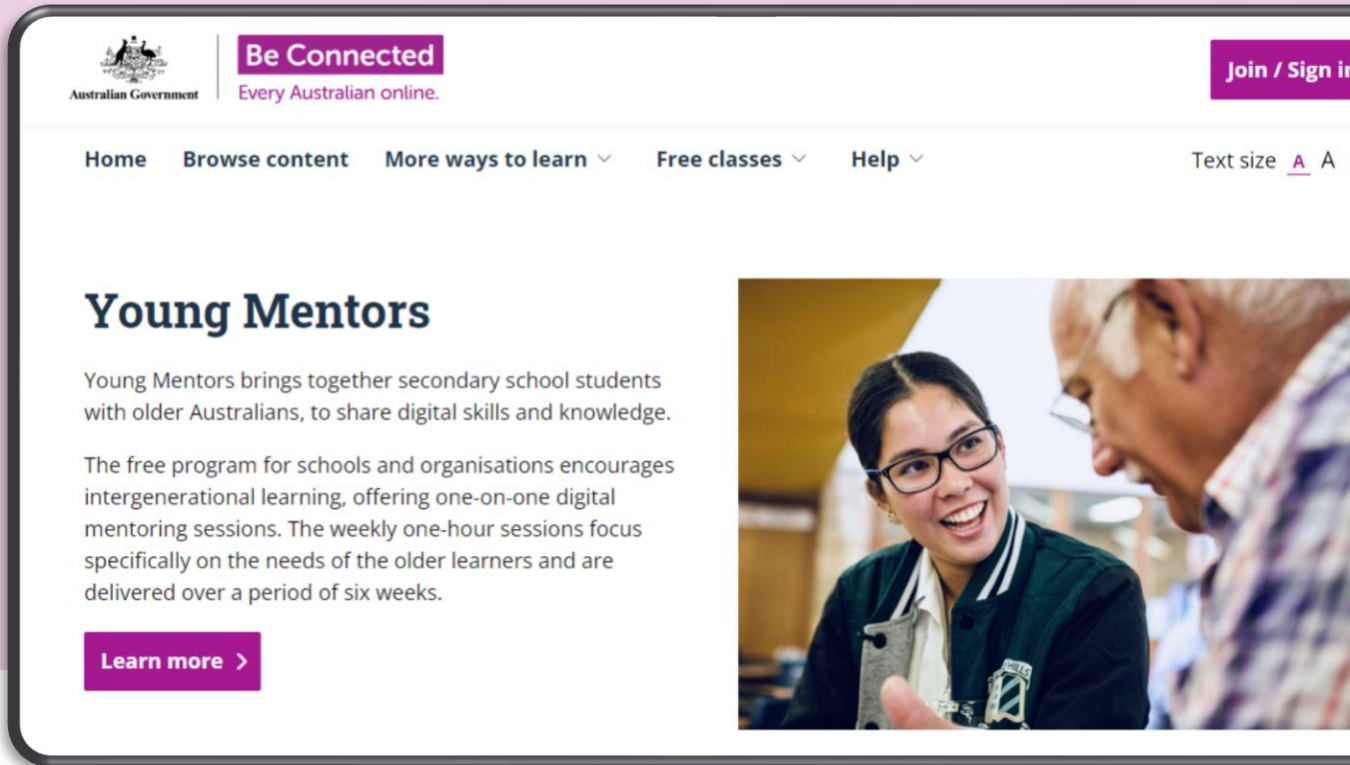
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Young Mentors program

Young Mentors brings together secondary school students with older Australians, to share digital skills and knowledge.

The free program for schools and organisations encourages intergenerational learning, offering one-on-one digital mentoring sessions. The weekly one-hour sessions focus specifically on the needs of the older learners and are delivered over a period of six weeks.
