Statement delivered by H.E Mr. Ahmed Zuhair, Minister of State of Transport and Civil Aviation Agenda item 2. Review of the implementation of the Regional Action Programme for Sustainable Transport Development in Asia and the Pacific 21 November 2022

Dear Chairperson, Distinguished delegates, and attendees. Good morning and Assalam aliakum,

This meeting is a very encouraging event which the Maldives welcomes in full force. After the fourth Ministerial conference on Transport held in 2021, the participants of that conference adopted the declaration on sustainable transport development in Asia and the pacific 2022 - 2026.
