Summary

The present document compares the proposed core set of economic statistics developed by the ESCAP Technical Advisory Group on the Development of Economic Statistics with the Early Warning and Business Cycle Indicators and Principal Global Indicators. It also contains information about the current availability of the core set statistics in the ESCAP region.

Comparison of the core set of economic statistics with other international sets of statistics and its availability in the ESCAP region

- 1. In document E/ESCAP/CST(2)/4, the secretariat introduces a proposed core set of economic statistics which the ESCAP Technical Advisory Group on the Development of Economic Statistics (TAG) has been charged with developing pursuant to a decision of the Committee at its first session. The present document is an extension of the above-mentioned document and contains additional information about the core set of statistics.
- 2. Table 1 contains a comparison of the core set with two other international sets of statistics: the Early Warning and Business Cycle Indicators developed under the guidance of the United Nations Statistics Division; and the Principal Global Indicators developed by the Inter-Agency Group on Economic and Financial Statistics.²
- 3. Table 2 contains information about the current availability of the core set of statistics in the ESCAP region.
