EW4ALL Objectives

By 2027, cover all people on Earth with an EWS that is:

- **Multi-Hazard**
- **End-to-End**
- **People Centered**



EW4ALL Structure & Objectives

Pillar 1



Disaster risk knowledge

Systematically collect data and undertake risk assessments

- Are the hazards and the vulnerabilities well known by the communities?
- What are the patterns and trends in these factors?
- Are risk maps and data widely available?

Pillar 2



Detection, observations, monitoring, analysis and forecasting of hazards

Develop hazard monitoring and early warning services

- Are the right parameters being monitored?
- Is there a sound scientific basis for making forecasts?
- Can accurate and timely warnings be generated?

Pillar 4



Preparedness and response capabilities

Build national and community response capabilities

- Are response plans up to date and tested?
- Are local capacities and knowledge made use of?
- Are people prepared and ready to react to warnings?

Pillar 3







Warning dissemination and communication

Communicate risk information and early warnings

- Do warnings reach all of those at risk?
- Are the risks and warnings understood?
- Is the warning information clear and usable?

Process

- GAP analysis
 - Prompting questions which identified gaps based on needs
 - Enabled pillar leads with direction and a pathway onto the roadmap
- Formulation of the Roadmap
 - objectives and activities flowed from the gaps identified
 - Budgets needed research in most instances, estimates were used.
 - Stock take of existing projects at pillar lead agencies (included in the roadmap).
