SUMMARY

The strategic framework and outputs proposed for possible inclusion in the programme of work for the biennium 2010-2011 for subprogramme 5, Information and communications technology and disaster risk reduction, is submitted for the Committee's review and further guidance. It should be noted that indicative budget planning figures for the preparation of the programme budget for 2010-2011 have yet to be issued by United Nations Headquarters. Hence, the secretariat may be required to make slight adjustments to the outputs in the course of preparing the programme budget for the biennium 2010-2011. The draft programme of work for 2010-2011 will be reviewed by the Advisory Committee of Permanent Representatives and Other Representatives Designated by Members of the Commission, and submitted to the Commission at its sixty-fifth session for endorsement and subsequently to the General Assembly for adoption in 2009.

1. INTRODUCTION

1. The present document contains a set of outputs proposed for inclusion in the draft programme of work for the biennium 2010-2011 in respect of subprogramme 5, Information and communications technology and disaster risk reduction, within the framework of the strategic framework for the period 2010-2011, as endorsed by the Commission at its sixty-fourth session and the Committee for Programme and Coordination at its forty-eighth session.

2. The programme thrust for subprogramme 5 is aimed at strengthening regional cooperation for the improved management of disasters and associated socioeconomic risks and to promote the application of information and communications technology (ICT) for socio-economic development in the ESCAP region.

2. STRATEGIC FRAMEWORK FOR 2010-2011

3. Under subprogramme 5, Information and communications technology and disaster risk reduction, the following expected accomplishments have been endorsed by the Commission at its sixty-fourth session and the Committee for Programme and Coordination at its forty-eighth session as the programme framework for the preparation of the programme of work.

EXPECTED ACCOMPLISHMENT (a): Increased sharing of knowledge among ESCAP member States on policy options, strategies and best practices for ICT connectivity and for integrating multi-hazard disaster risk reduction into national development.

EXPECTED ACCOMPLISHMENT (b): Strengthened regional cooperative mechanisms in support of ICT connectivity and disaster risk management.

EXPECTED ACCOMPLISHMENT (c): Improved capabilities of ESCAP member States in the field of multi-hazard assessment, preparedness, early warning and response to disaster risks.

EXPECTED ACCOMPLISHMENT (d): Improved institutional capacity of ESCAP member States to apply ICT for socio-economic development.
