➤ Population - 3.7 million


➤ Capital – Tbilisi - Population 1.2 million

√ 2014 General Population Census



2014 General Population Census

Census date: November 5-19, 2014

Duration: 15 days

- Midnight of November 5 was defined as the reference period
- 2014 Census was conducted with PAPI method
- Resident population (de jure) were enumerated (who has been living in the country at least one year before reference date or has intent to live at least 12 months)
- Geo coordinates collected
- Agricultural Census was conducted together with Population Census
- Dissemination Geostat web-page, census portal, analytical reports etc.





2024 General Population Census

- Census date: November 14-19 December, 2024
- Duration: 36 days
- Midnight of November 14 was defined as the reference period
- Census will be conducted with CAWI and CAPI method
- Resident population (de jure) will be enumerated (who has been living in the country at least one year before reference date or has intent to live at least 12 months)
- Geo coordinates will be collected
- Agricultural Census will be conducted together with Population Census
- Dissemination Geostat web-page, census portal, analytical reports etc.



Administrative data sources in Georgia (1)

- Ministry of Justice: ID registry, Birth and Death registry, Marriage and Divorce registry, Address Registry, Building Registry, Enterprise Registry
- Ministry of Internal Affairs: Border Cross Statistics
- Ministry of Education: Secondary School Students Registry
- Ministry of Internally Displaced Persons from the Occupied Territories: IDP Registry, Pensioners Registry, Social Package Receivers Registry.
- Ministry of Finance, Revenue Service: Income Register, Tax Register
- Ministry of Agriculture: Farm Registry
- Geostat: Statistical Business Register (SBR)

Administrative data sources in Georgia (2)

❖ To establish population register – among priorities of Geostat for next coming years


Activities has been started under the NSDS for 2020-2023

Interagency working group on population register issues has been established

❖ Future EU twinning project will cover topics related to PR

Use of administrative data

- ➤ 2014 Census Personal identification number (PIN) was collected and linked to PSDA ID Database
- ➤ 2014 Census GIS maps from Public Registry Agency, Ministry of Justice were used for listing of households and updating addresses
- Annual population statistics Geostat uses annual administrative data of births and deaths (PSDA) and estimated date of external migration based on border crossing administrative data (MIA)

2024 Census challenges and future plans

➤ Confidentiality issue - raising awareness among population on Census-planned to have during 2024

➤ No internal migration data in place - Establish the Population Register << ongoing activity

➤ Accesses to private companies individual data (e.g. insurance companies, electricity supply companies and etc.) — change existing legislation and approximate it with GLOSS (generic law on Official statistics) << ongoing activity
