Moreover, leading companies in Mongolia will share their experiences in integrating sustainability into their business strategies and navigating the evolving landscape of reporting requirements.

Notably, the event will feature the dissemination of climate-related information disclosure guidance explicitly tailored for Mongolian FIs, equipping them with practical examples to enhance their sustainability reporting practices. Through knowledge exchange and collaborative engagement, this side event endeavors to catalyze actionable steps towards a more resilient and environmentally responsible business environment in Mongolia.
