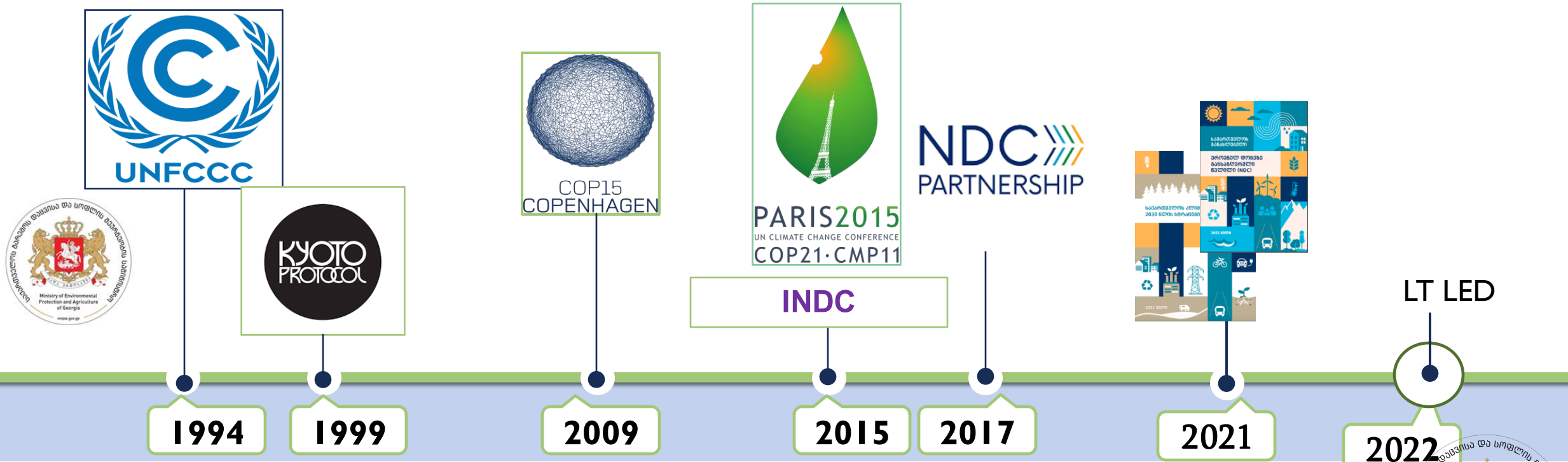

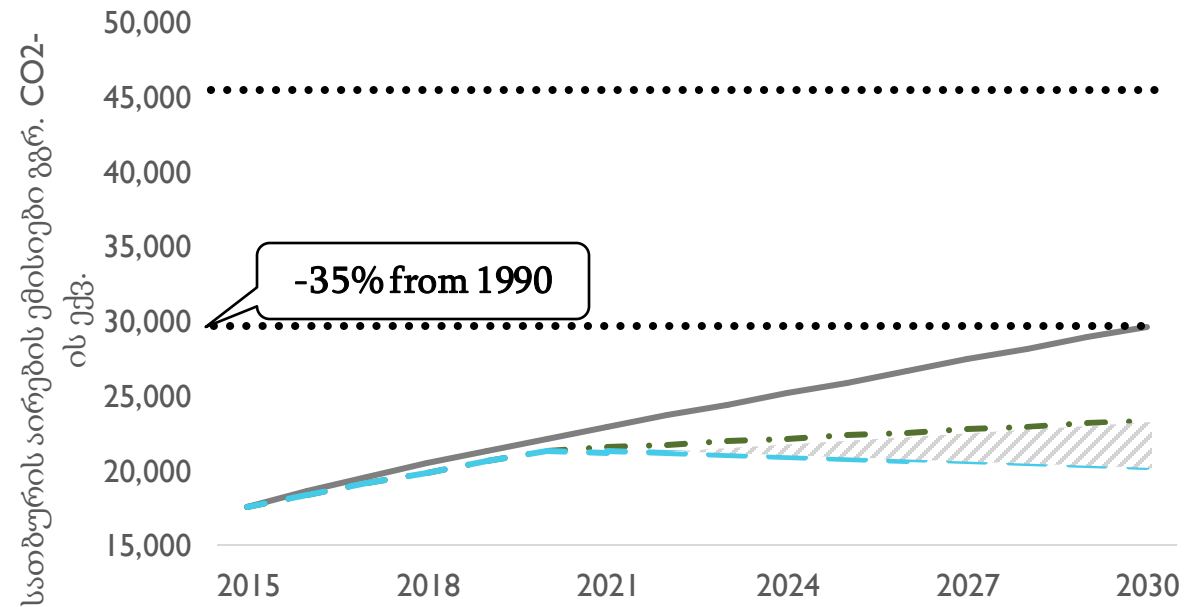

NATIONALLY DETERMINED CONTRIBUTION (NDC)

NDC GOAL

- Unconditional commitment- 1990 - 35%
- Conditional commitment - 1990 -50%-57%
- Exploring adaptation capabilities and implementing adaptation measures
- Implementation timeline- 2021-2030
- Base year- 1990

AIM & SECTORIAL GOALS

- **Aim of the strategy**

Reduce greenhouse gas emissions by 35% by 2030 compared to 1990 levels.

- **Action Plan**

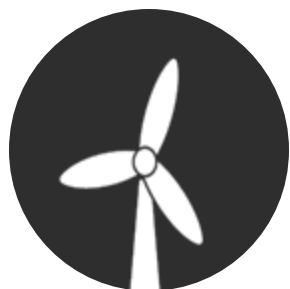

Shortly about the Document

Baseline Year: 2016
Time period: 2020-2050
Approach: Pessimistic and Optimistic
Scenarios: WOM (Baseline);WEM;WAM
Basic drivers of Prognosis: Population (P+T), GDP, Sectoral drivers



LONG-TERM (2050) LOW EMISSION DEVELOPMENT STRATEGY (LT LEDS)

- Document defines the long-term vision
- Aims to identify additional measures to promote sustainable development of economy sectors

CLIMATE CHANGE COUNCIL

Intergovernmental institution to coordinate development and implementation of Climate Change Policy

Mandate: Ensure effective implementation of the UN Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC), the Kyoto Protocol and the Paris Agreement.



BUDGET TAGGING

- World Bank Project
- Started in the MEPA and its' Agencies
- Involves 5 Ministries

MONITORING, REPORTING AND VERIFICATION (MRV) SYSTEM

- Currently project-based approach
- Energy Community Obligation
- Development of the MRV System
- EU financed project is underway to analyze the gaps and prepare the roadmap for the development of MRV system
