

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

Follow-up and review plays a critical role in ensuring effective SDG implementation, much of which needs to happen at the national level




Voluntary	Encourage reporting and include developed and developing countries
Country-led	Country-driven reviews of progress at national and sub-national levels
Rigorous and based on evidence	Informed by country-led evaluations and data, which is high-quality, accessible, reliable and disaggregated
Learning experience	Facilitate the sharing of experiences, including successes, challenges and lessons learned, part of an ongoing process
National circumstances	Reviews in accordance with national circumstances, policies and priorities, together with relevant partners
Open, Inclusive, Participatory	Includes supporting reporting on progress by all relevant stakeholders

PREPARATORY PHASE



Where to start?

Take stock of previous VNR process and report - lessons and challenges

Review and refresh institutional arrangements and establish VNR Team

Identify resources needed: financial, technical, human resources

Plan how to engage stakeholders & communicate about the VNR

Data gap analysis/SDG Progress Assessment, collect data from ministries



The most powerful way to get the main messages across in a VNR is to develop a **storyline** that ties together the report.

A storyline is the **overarching message** of the report

What's next?

Develop theme of report/storyline and SDGs to focus on


Review and analyse data and findings on SDG trajectory since past VNR

Review national SDG indicator framework and plan statistical annex

Start communication, outreach and stakeholder engagement activities











Include a strong **storyline** on key SDGs relevant to the national contextnot just an update on SDGs

Evidence-based and analytical, assess implementation challenges

Policy coherence for an integrated agenda, identify and assess tradeoffs or synergies in policy strategies

Forward looking, include concrete action plans and next steps, that address findings of past VNRs and address future context

Highly participatory, engage government and stakeholders in discussions on next steps and how integrate VNR findings into national plans

Include a **feedback mechanism**, lessons learned are considered in domestic policy formulation and introduced in public discourse



HOW VNRs SUPPORT SDG ACCELLERATION

INCORPORATION of SDGs into NATIONAL FRAMEWORKS

Identify gaps, assess challenges and recommend strategies to overcome barriers

TRACK PROGRESS

Improve data collection and analysis, filling data gaps, set-up national monitoring coordination mechanisms Stronger policy-data integration Enhanced evidence-based policy making

INTEGRATED SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT

Assess interlinkages and synergies, improve institutional arrangements and coordination

MOBILISE MEANS of IMPLEMENTATION

Assess financing gaps and identify new opportunities, beyond business as usual

PARTNERSHIPS

Enhance communication, coordination and collaboration among sectors and stakeholders domestically and internationally

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

WRAP UP: HOW to INCREASE the IMPACT of a VNR



Substantive content, analytical depth and policy focus

Create a strong **narrative**

Use the data – utilize data analysis to develop a national indicator framework (SDG Progress Assessment)

Create platforms for safe and open dialogue with stakeholders that continues beyond the VNR

Identify **the means of implementation** Leverage **transformative change**

Outline practical next steps & follow up actions

Plan the post-VNR period – how the review will be presented to parliament and integrated into monitoring and review processes
