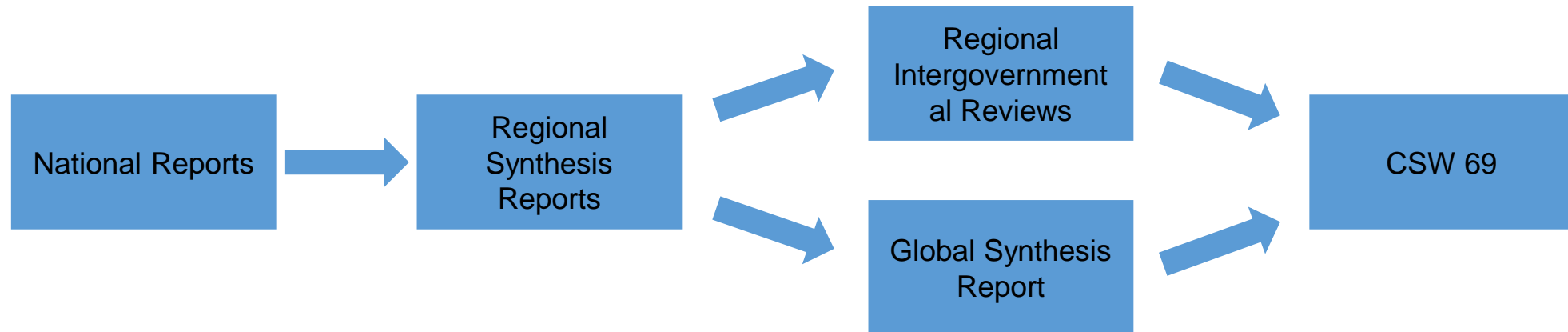

Context

- In March 2025, CSW 69 will undertake a review and appraisal of progress made in the implementation of the BD & PfA
- All States are called upon to undertake comprehensive national-level reviews
- Reviews should build synergies with the 2030 Agenda



Objectives of the National Reviews

- assess progress made in implementation and identify challenges
- take stock of achievements
- identify gaps and setbacks
- outline strategies for addressing gaps and challenges
- result in renewed commitments and clear sets of priority actions
- help mobilize means of implementation and partnerships
- support the identification of solutions and best practices
- promote the coordination and effectiveness of national, regional and international actions

Institutional Set up and Communications

- Leadership placed with the head of the national mechanism for GEWE
- All-of-government approach and coordination
- Access to data and collaboration with national statistical offices
- All-of-society approach and collaboration
- Communications in diverse media



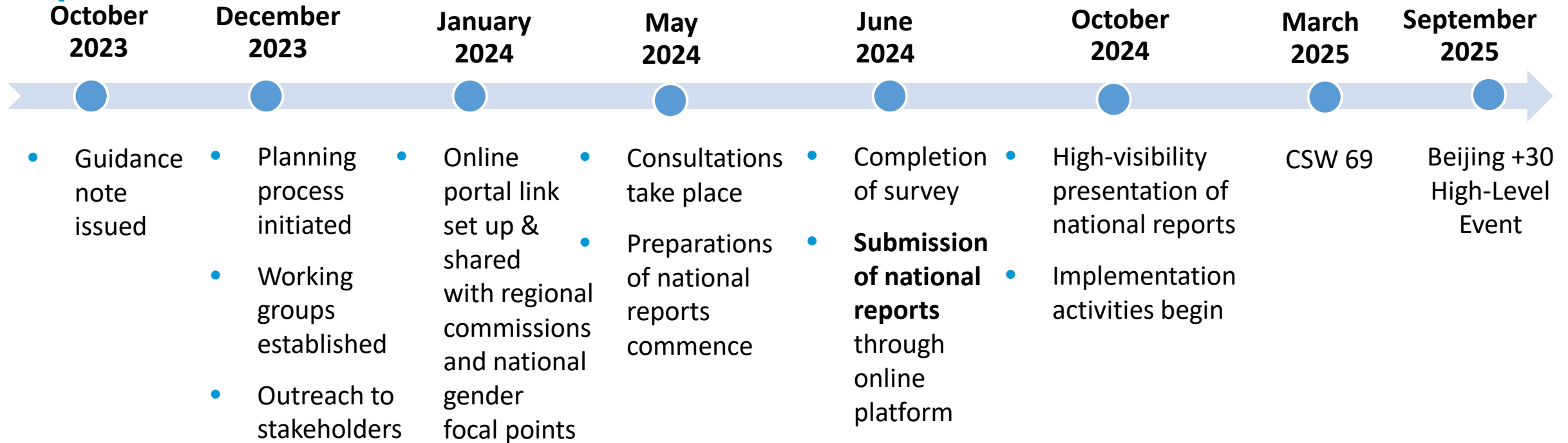

All of society approach: Fiji



- National Women's Machinery led participatory, consultative process
- Formulation of **working group** including civil society, women's rights organisations, government agencies and faith-based organisations
- **Advertisements in daily newspaper** to invite participation of public
- Working group led **writing sections of report**, supported by Women's Ministry rep
- Concerns: short timeframe, non-formal process
- **Plans to formalize process for +30 review**

Timeline





Submission of national reports

- National reports will be submitted through an **online platform** (*new!*)
- The exercise consists of two parts
 - **Narrative report**
 - **Online survey** (multiple choice)
- A guidance note has been shared to help member states navigate the process
- Links to the online portal have been shared with designated national focal points
- Member states are asked to respond to the survey and submit national reports by **1 June**

Proposed Structure of national reports

- The Guidance Note proposes a structure for the report that **maximizes synergies** for monitoring and report progress on the implementation of the **BPfA** and the **2030 Agenda**
 - To do so, the **12 critical areas** of concern have been clustered into **6 dimensions**:
 1. Inclusive development, shared prosperity, and decent work
 2. Poverty eradication, social protection, and social services
 3. Freedom from violence, stigma, and stereotypes
 4. Participation, accountability, and gender-responsive institutions
 5. Peaceful and inclusive societies
 6. Environmental conservation, protection, and rehabilitation
 - The **human rights** of women and the girl child should be addressed across these dimensions
- The online multiple-choice survey will follow the same structure

Further guidance on narrative report (1)

Introduction and summary

- 1–2-pages
- main achievements, challenges and setbacks over the past five years
- a maximum of 2 promising best practices

Priorities, achievements, challenges and setbacks

- 10-15 pages max.
- contextual analysis with a focus on the past five years
- Identification of any new and emerging priorities for the future

Progress across the six clusters

- 50 pages max.
- detailed analysis of measures taken in the past five years
- Mainstream attention to HR and girl child and, where possible, provide information about measures for marginalized groups of women and girls

Further guidance on Narrative report (2)

State of national institutions and processes

- 7 pages max
- national processes and mechanisms on the implementation and monitoring of BD & PfA
- Links with Agenda 2030 and HR processes (CEDAW)

State of gender data and statistics

- 6 pages max
- progress on the availability of data disaggregated by sex and gender statistics
- Links with the gender-responsive monitoring of the 2030 Agenda

Conclusions and next steps

- 1-2 pages
- forward-looking reflections on future challenges
- priority actions to accelerate implementation of the BPfA and the 2030 Agenda

ONLINE PORTAL AND SURVEY

- A password protected link has been shared with the designated national focal point
- **Multiple-choice survey** that mirrors the structure of the narrative report
- Very important for regional and global stock-take that all member states fill out the survey
- Recommended to prepare survey answers in advance and enter in one go
- Opportunity to **upload narrative report at the end**
- No edits will be possible after submission

Welcome to the online platform for the upload of national reports on progress in the implementation of the Beijing Declaration and Platform for Action (BPfA) on the occasion of the 30th anniversary of the Fourth World Conference on the Status of Women.

At its 69th session in March 2025, the United Nations Commission on the Status of Women will undertake a review and appraisal of progress in the implementation of the BPfA.

As per the note verbale and guidance note shared in September 2023, all Member States are encouraged to undertake comprehensive national review processes to produce national reports taking stock of progress, gaps, and challenges in the implementation of the BPfA.

As in previous years, national reports will feed into the respective regional synthesis reports that Regional Commissions will prepare for their respective regional intergovernmental reviews. They will also feed into a global synthesis report that UN-Women will submit to the 69th session of the Commission on the Status of Women.

This year, the national report submission will take place through this online portal and be preceded by a multiple-choice survey to make the process more efficient and facilitate the aggregation of findings for the regional and global reports. A password protected link has been shared with the designated national focal point for this purpose.

We advise you to **prepare your answers in advance** of entering them into the online platform, since it will not be possible to save your work and continue at a different time. For ease of reference and to enable prior preparation, the survey questions were already included in the guidance note.


Respondents will be able to upload their narrative national reports at the end of the survey.

We kindly ask all Member States to complete the survey and upload their national reports by **1 June 2024**.

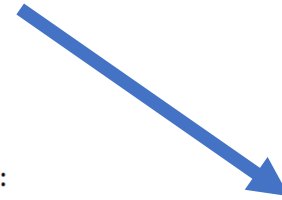
