






PROPOSED VIETNAM ENERGY PROFILE BY 2050







Investment Opportunities

LNG Projects in DRAFT PDP VIII

- Gas-fired power projects (including LNG-to-power): 24.9% 27% of the country's energy mix by 2030.
- 16 LNG projects in total
 - o 11 projects in the revised PDP VII, and
 - o 5 new projects in the Draft PDP VIII (2 new LNG projects and 3 projects shifting from coal-fired to LNG).
- 2 LNG-to-power projects (1,500 MW each) (to be put in COD before 2030): Ca Na, Long Son pending selection of investors.

Legal Framework for Private Acquisition of LNG-to-Power Projects

Key procedures

Circumstances triggering such procedures

Acquisition Approval

- If there is an increase of foreign ownership exceeding 50% of the charter capital; or
- The project is located in areas deemed "sensitive" to national security.

Enterprise Registration Certificate Amendment

- The project company is incorporated in a form of a limited liability company; or
- There is any change to the registered enterprise information (e.g. legal representative, company name).

Investment Registration
Certificate / Investment Policy
Decision/
Amendment

- There is any change to the particulars of the project; or
- There is any change to the information of the investor.

BOT Contract Amendment

- The project has been developed on a BOT-basis; and
- BOT Contract contains a provision that requires an amendment.

Roadmap to "Green" Ports in Vietnam

2021-2025

- Issuing Technical Regulation on Vietnam Greenport Criteria
- Implementing green ports pilot scheme
- Encouraging the implementation of Green Ports Project
- Proposing to amend master plan to comply with Green Ports Project

2025-2030

- Issuing Technical National Standard on Vietnam Greenport Criteria
- Implementing the voluntary application of the National Standard
- Amending relevant regulations to comply with Green Ports Project
- Assessing the result of the Green Ports Project

2030 onwards

• Compulsory application of the Green Port Criteria in master planning, investment, construction of ports in Vietnam



Role of Gas in "Green" Ports



- Draft Technical Regulation on Vietnam Greenport Criteria.
- At least 15% clean energy (e.g., renewables, LNG, hydro, ammonia) to be used in transportation, port operation, maritime transport.
- Implementing measures/policy to motivate and incentivize the use of clean energy
