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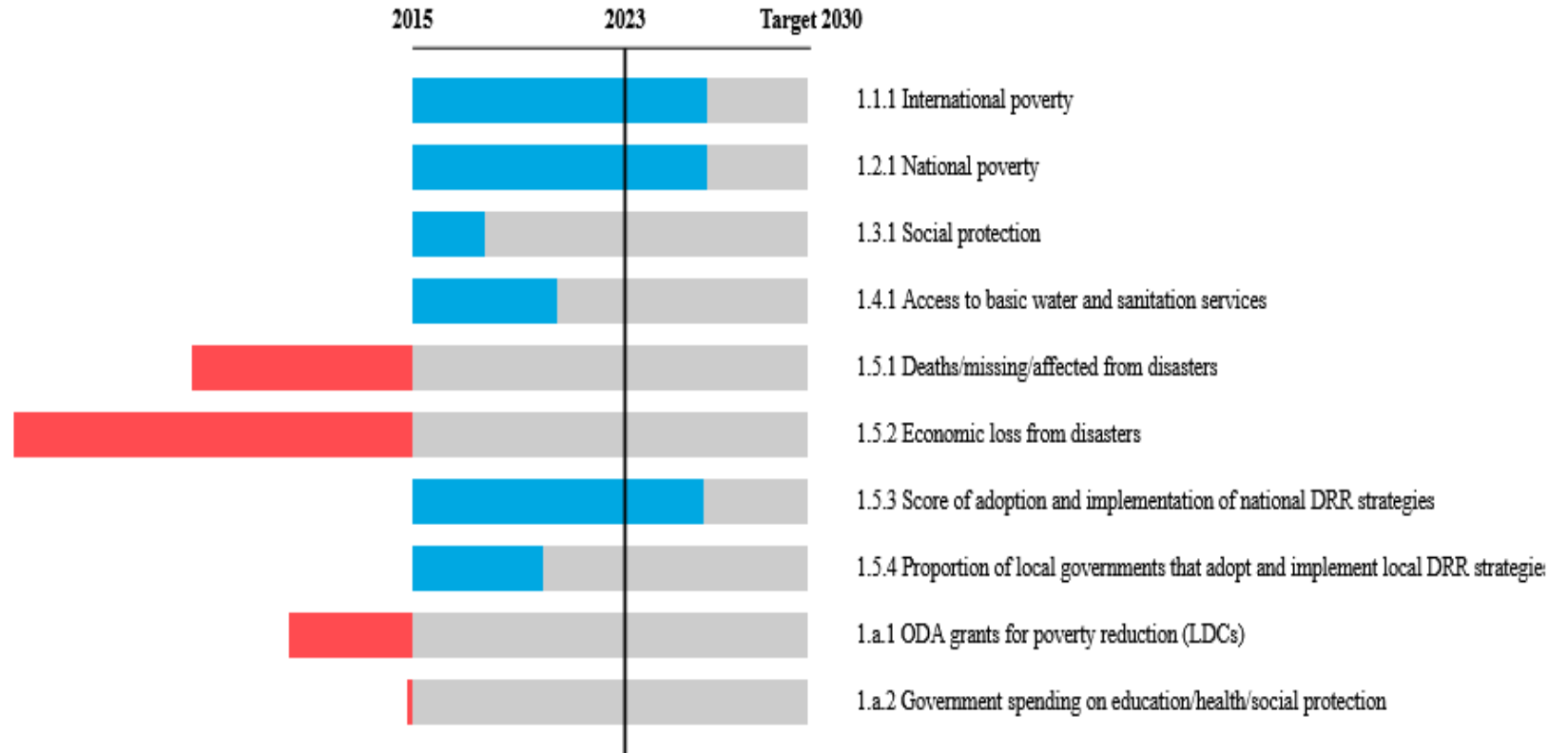

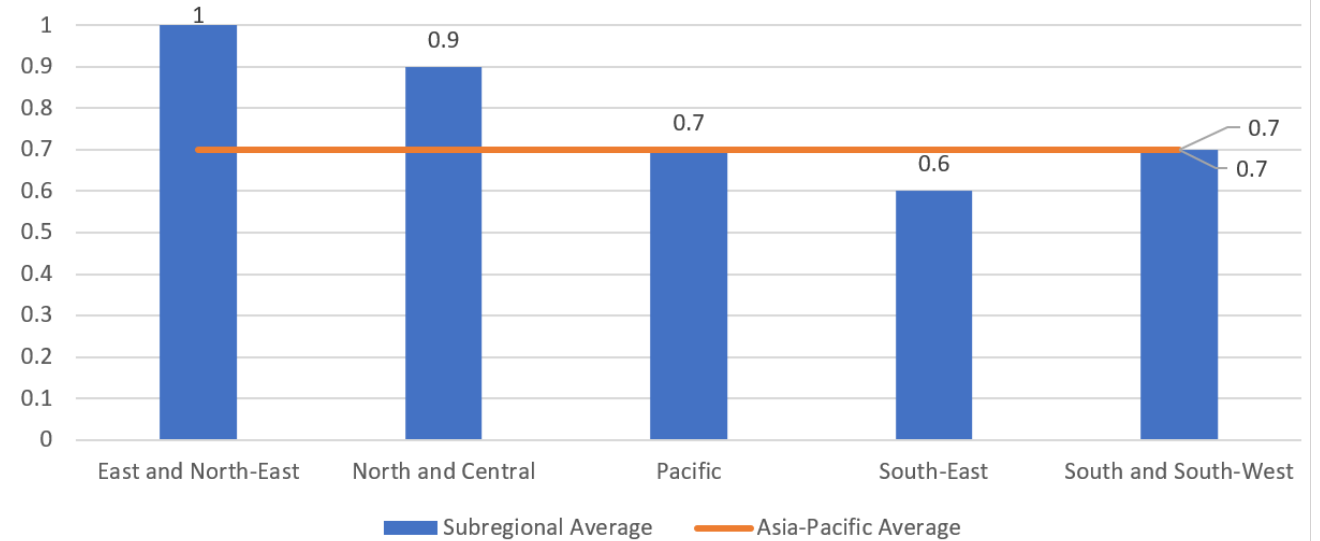
Target 1.1: Several countries eliminated extreme poverty as of 2022, but progress too slow in some other countries

PRIORITIES FOR ACTION



Adopt integrated policy planning for inclusive and adaptive social protection to leave no one behind

Invest in data-collection and building capacity for data analysis, including by gender, age, disability



Upgrade skills to support access to decent jobs during a just transition, especially for young people



Improve domestic resource mobilization and leverage emerging sources of external financing
