Consider a new mechanism

- Regional expert group on integrated statistics and innovation
 - to replace the Strategic Advisory Body for the Modernization of Statistical production and Services in Asia and the Pacific (SAB-AP)

Involve global and subregional mechanisms

- Support sub-regional statistics development strategies
- Support downstream implementation and application of tools and other resources resulting from global work
