## Statement from Vietnam on Gender

First of all, on behalf of the General Statistics Office of Vietnam, I would like to appreciate the review highlighting the opportunities for taking collective action to improve gender data and statistics in Asia and the Pacific. In terms of SDGs, the Vietnam SDG indicators, which will be issued at the end of this year, will probably consist of 67 gender-specific indicators. All of this show that Vietnam is trying our best to implement our commitment related to improvement of gender equality and empowerment.

After the issuance of the Vietnam SDG indicators and the set of indicators on gender development, for maintaining our production of gender indicators, I would like to call for support from development partners, especially UN-Women. I am looking forward to cooperating with you all in implementing gender statistics.
