Most of the 11 domain of core set population and social statistics can be produced by BPS-Statistics Indonesia to answer the issue no one left behind.

For this purpose, BPS-Statistics Indonesia doing some survey, such as Susenas (National Socio economic Survey) and Sakernas (Labour Force Survey). Starting from 2018, from those surveys are incorporated the disability questions related the short-set questions of Washington Group, so that the indicator of SDGs resulted from those survey can be disaggregated by sex, urban and rural, provincial, disable and non disable, migrant and non migrant, and from the Susenas, It can also be disaggregated into poor and non poor people.

- Currently from Susenas and Sakernas, and other socio-economic surveys, BPS-Statistics Indonesia can obtain around 97 indicators for SDGs. Besides that by coordinating with the Line Ministries, BPS can also produced around 34 indicators.
- From 97 Indicators produced by BPS, there is around 33 indicators which already meet the standard global
- There is around 183 indicators, which becoming responsibility of Other Line Ministries. BPS, Ministry of Planning and the line Ministry make a good collaboration and coordination in validating these data, which will be used for the SDGs monitoring data.
