National Statistics Office of Georgia collects the individual data-base of vital events from Public Service development Agency (PSDA), which is regulated by the Law on Official Statistics of Georgia.

Starting from 2011 the medical certificates of births and deaths are filled electronically and automatically sent to the PSDA.

Using of personal identification numbers and special electronic system, database is cleansed and structured to avoid some duplicates and to ensure high quality of personal data.

For fulfillment of information about missing values, such as age etc., information related the birth date (if provided) is used, otherwise Geostat uses median age of the same groups, for imputation of missing values.
