Lao PDR delegate would like to congratulation as you be the chair of Six Secession of the committee on Statistics, as well as the chair this agenda item.

Since the Lao PDR has been affected by floods in many provinces in this year, especially the in south part of Lao PDR was flood by with Hydropower Dam, so we have learned for this disaster that if we have information in early that will be less damaged.

LSB has a project collaborative with Luxembourg on the Environmental Statistics, which is one of the four types of official statistics mentioned in Lao Statistical Law, while we are now not yet full implementing those set of environmental statistics,

Lao PDR have a plan to working closely with concern ministry, especially the Ministry of Natural Resource and Environment to set up national indicators.

Lao PDR will also continue working with the international Development Partner as well as the UNICEF and others.
