-On June 2019, at the G20 Energy and Environment Ministers, Asia-Pacific Adaptation Information Platform (AP-PLAT) was established with the kind support of Indonesia and the participation of Thailand.

- Next March, Japan will host The 7th Asia-Pacific Adaptation Forum on line. Toward this forum, we are in the process of making it accessible to anyone for free to CMIP6, data of the future weather change.

-Air pollution in the Asia-Pacific region is of grave concern and has to be addressed for sustainable development.

-In this regard, Monitoring Network in East Asia (EANET), established in 2001, works effectively as an intergovernmental initiative to create a common understanding on the state of acid deposition problems in East Asia.

-With 13 countries in the region, Japan will extend the scope of its activities to the whole air pollution issue. We expect more countries and organization to join this important initiative to make a progress for air pollution the Asia-Pacific region.
